2. Summary of the Evaluation Findings

This Accessibility Conformance Report uses the VPAT® Version 2.5 (Revised) template to describe the conformance of the Omeka Admin Site with WCAG 2.2 AA Success Criterion.

Product Description

The Omeka Admin Portal under review is the administrative dashboard where users can manage the content shared by their Omeka websites. The Admin Portal gives users the ability to customize the functionality of their websites and manage individual resources and modules.

Additional Notes

This audit was conducted in accordance with the accessibility audit process developed by QualityLogic. This process was based on WCAG-EM (WCAG Evaluation Method). Details on evaluation methods and scope can be found in the Scope of Evaluation section below.

Evaluation Findings

Based on this evaluation, the Omeka Admin Site does not meet WCAG 2.2, Conformance Level AA. Detailed review results are available in the Results and Recommended Actions section below. Scope of Evaluation

The Omeka Admin Site was audited to verify compliance with the Web Content Accessibility Success Criteria (WCAG) 2.2 Level AA by the QualityLogic team from March 28, 2022, through April 22, 2022, and again from November 20, 2025, through December 4, 2025.

Accessibility compliance was audited with automated accessibility tests and manually with the following assistive technologies:

- Job Access With Speech (JAWS) 2026
- Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA)
- Mac VoiceOver

3. Results and Recommended Actions

Below are the audit results for conformance against WCAG 2.2 AA standards.

Users with limited or no color vision may struggle to interpret the information these color changes convey. 2.1.1 Keyboard	Does Not Support	<p>On some tested pages, interactive elements cannot be operated using only a keyboard, excluding users who rely on keyboard navigation. Specifically, the map pins are not accessible via keyboard input, preventing interaction without a mouse; the Appearance Navigation section does not allow users to reorder links using keyboard commands; and the editor toolbar cannot be activated through keyboard controls or lacks instructions for doing so. Defects

The following defects and compliance issues were identified during the audit.

Issue severity is categorized into the following levels:

- **Blocker:** This issue blocks access to critical areas on the product under test or has a large impact on core functionality
- **Critical:** This issue fails one of the WCAG 2.2 success criteria

An issue's status can be one of the following:

- **Open:** A fix has not been implemented for this issue and it still infringes upon the compliance of the product under test.
- **3rd Party – Open:** This issue is due to the utilization of 3rd party content that cannot be addressed by the author. Issues with this status still infringe upon the compliance of the product under test.
- **Closed:** This issue is fixed and no longer poses an issue for accessibility. Issues with this status do not infringe upon the compliance of the product under test.
